- Auditing:** Throughout the process the documents must be tracked to ensure that all information is accounted for.
- Indexing:** The migration process provides an opportunity to not only move the existing metadata, but also to add or enrich the indexes available.
- Loading:** Insert or load documents, metadata and resources into the target ECM system and ensure that fidelity and accessibility are retained.

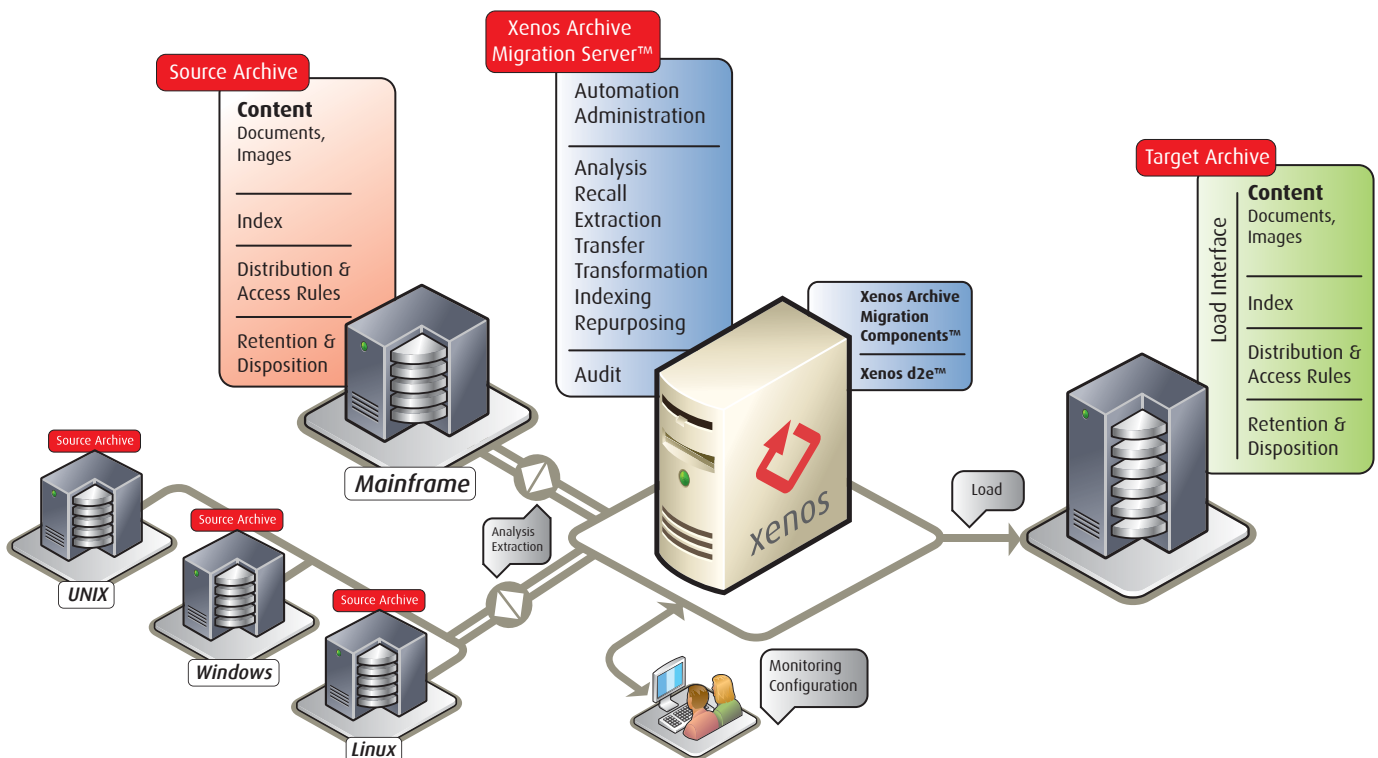
